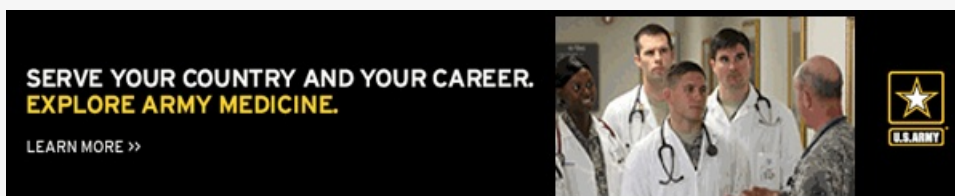
TCEP Connect 2018
